a busy spring

to come.

Sales are heating up! The days are getting longer, and the weather is getting warmer. Although we're only two months into the new year, there are a lot of signs pointing to a busy spring to come. There's been a significant increase in activity within our community in the past few weeks. So far this calendar year 15 properties have already been sold in Crown Isle. There has also been a considerable number of listings coming online in the past weeks (20) reaching a total of 60 properties listed within the Crown Isle community.

Regionally, the benchmark price of a single-family home in the Campbell River area last month was \$437,300, an increase of 4% over last year. In the Comox Valley, the benchmark

price reached \$521,900, also up by 4% from one year ago (and a whopping 167% increase over the past five years). Nanaimo's benchmark price rose by 4% to \$562,700 in January, while the Parksville-Qualicum area saw its price drop slightly to \$571,400.

Kaye Broens, president-elect of the Vancouver Island Real Estate Board, states that the recent release of home assessments tends to create confusion for consumers, who are not always aware that the assessed figure is based on data that is several months old and may not reflect current market value.
