GREYSTONE ESTATES is now Registered!

Greystone Estates, our newest development within the Crown Isle Community off Majestic Drive, is now registered! The two approved home builders for the Greystone development, Jayson Welsh - Crown Isle Homes & Bill Larson - Integra Homes, have submitted permits for 8 new custom homes to start once approved with several more plans not far behind. Of the 54 Single Family Lots, 27 have been contracted directly to future homeowners along with an additional 10 lots to the two approved builders. Remaining lots start at \$459,900. The development will also have two multi-sites on Lots 6 & 13 in Phase Two. Our development team is still researching opportunities for each these sites.

Silverstone Patio Homes is well underway and close to finishing servicing and roadwork for the 48-unit gated strata development off Crown Isle Drive. Integra Homes has also started construction of the units in Phase One which will bring 11 units to market including a Show Suite as you come into the development. The Integra Team is forecasting completion of Phase One early in the Spring. FUTURE DEVELOPMENTS

Our development team continues to work with our engineers and the City of Courtenay on several of our Future Development Areas.

Over on The RISE on the north side of Ryan Road, we have submitted plans for Phases 5 & 6 which will include another 70 lots plus four multi-sites and a much needed second entrance / exit to Ryan Road. Pre-sales will begin later this year with road works and services not far behind. Our hope is to be able to start new home construction at some point next summer.

We are still working through the re-zoning application for the 40 acres behind Britannia Place and Corinthia Estates. This will bring more building lots and several multi-sites to Crown Isle plus a possible separate entrance / exit to the east part of the community out to Anderton Road. Separately we have

submitted a new application to rezone a small parcel that will allow Klass Enterprises to complete Phase V of Britannia Place (5 Buildings / 10 units).

Lastly, we are starting to consider options for the corner of Ryan Road and Anderton Road. This will likely have some commercial mixed with residential as it transitions back into the existing Community back toward the Golf Course.
