Your membership automatically includes participation in the Crown Isle Ladies' Club (CILC). We are delighted to have you as a member and want you help you enjoy all that CILC and Crown Isle have to offer.

Our mandate is to provide an organized schedule of golf on Tuesdays for the enjoyment of women golfers at all levels of experience and skill. There are two divisions of play: competitive and recreational. CILC also organizes several social events throughout the year:

- April 7th: Opening Day Shotgun and Luncheon
- May 26th: Captains' vs Vice-Captains' Team Competition & Spring Meeting "Peanut Butter Cup" luncheon
- July 15th: Evening Mix & Mingle Cocktail Party
- September 29th: Closing Day Shotgun, Luncheon and AGM
- Early December (date TBA): Holiday Luncheon

Sign up for for CILC Tuesday games, social events, and Crown Isle events and tournaments is all done through The Ladies' Club web page, accessed via [crownisle.com](http://crownisle.com). If you want to play in any of our weekly Tuesday women's events, you must first register for **Tuesday Ladies Day** at the beginning of the season, and then sign up for individual dates you are available to play. Registration cut off is 10 a.m. on the Thursday prior to each event.

Contact information for all CILC Executive members is found by clicking on 'Executive Information & Documents.' If you have any difficulties navigating the site, one of the Executive would be happy to assist you in getting started.

CILC members can also access "Ball in the Bag" tee times on Monday mornings. All you do to sign up is send an email to [dpetrie@crownsisle.ca](mailto:dpetrie@crownsisle.ca) and your name will be added to the mix. Tee times will be confirmed by email. *Registration deadline is noon each Friday.*

- **Ladies Interclub** - season-long team match play vs. Comox, Glacier Greens, Sunnydale, Storey Creek & Powell River. You don't have to be available to play in all 6 matches to join the team.
- **Ladies' Doubles Match Play** and **Ladies' Individual Match play** Match Play ladders, with results of matches updated with throughout the season.

# Tuesday Ladies

From early April to the end of September, women club members are welcome to participate in the Tuesday Ladies' group. Tee times are reserved each Tuesday morning for a weekly competition (Game of the Day) as well as non-competitive tee times (Recreational Golf). Click on the 'Tuesday Ladies Day' button below to register for the season and sign up for events. Once on that page, click the 'Calendar' tab and then choose the 'More Info' button for details about each week's competition.

For a comprehensive look at the weekly game schedule, click on the 'Fixture List and Game Descriptions' yellow tab.

## **Don't have a handicap yet?**

To be eligible to play in the Game of the Day, you must have an accurate, up-to-date handicap. If you do not yet have an established handicap, you are still welcome to play in Recreational Golf. Once you have three games completed (from any day) and scores entered in Golf Canada, your handicap will be calculated. You will then be eligible to play in the Game of the Day and other competitive Crown Isle events.

## **Entering scores from Tuesday play**

All women who play on Tuesdays, whether in the Game of the Day or Recreational Golf, are required to submit their scorecards via Golf Genius. Your score automatically upload to Golf Canada. Do not post own score into Golf Canada for Tuesday play.
